


PREAMBLE

- For the financial year 2020/2021 the municipality has a total MIG allocation of R 119,1 million and split as capital project of R113,1 million and operational funding of R5,9 million.
- After the reprioritization MIG capital was be adjusted downwards to R112,8 million and operational adjusted upwards to R6,3 million
